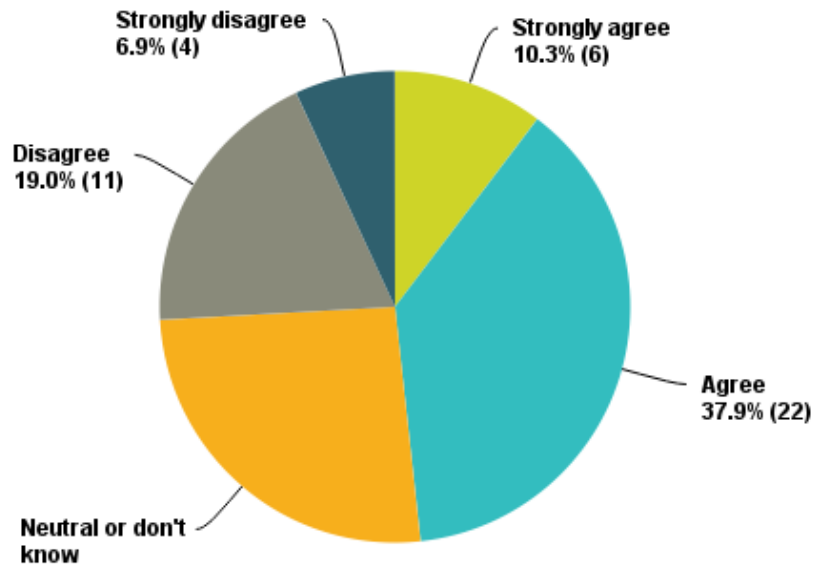

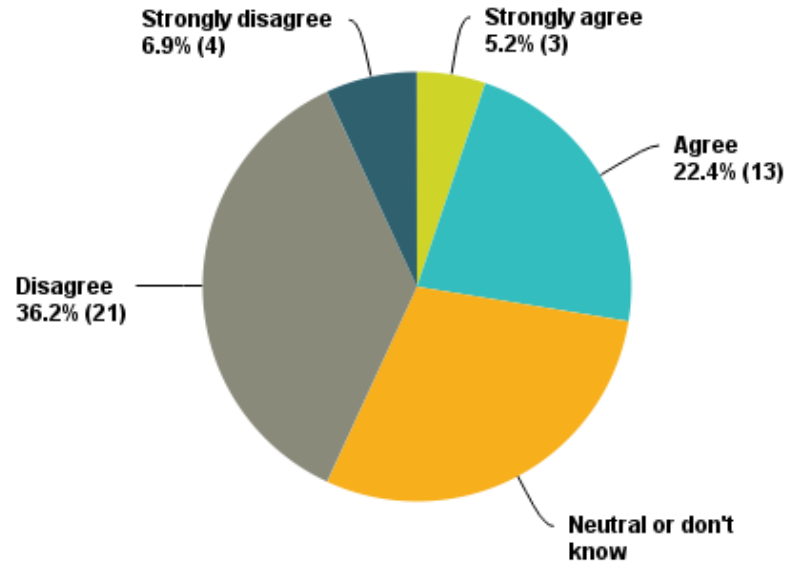

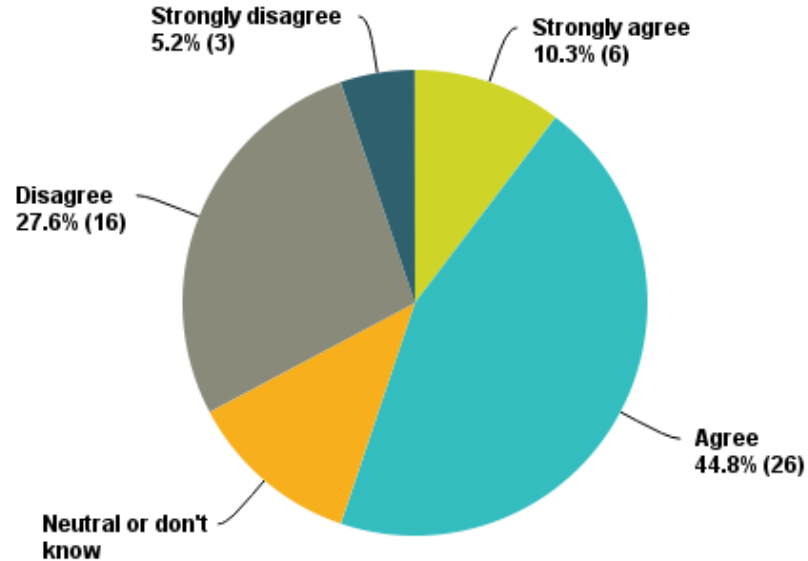

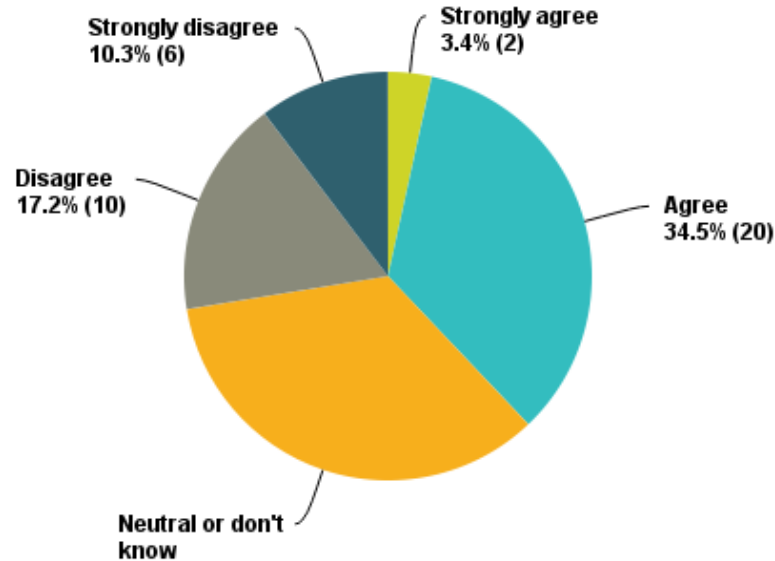

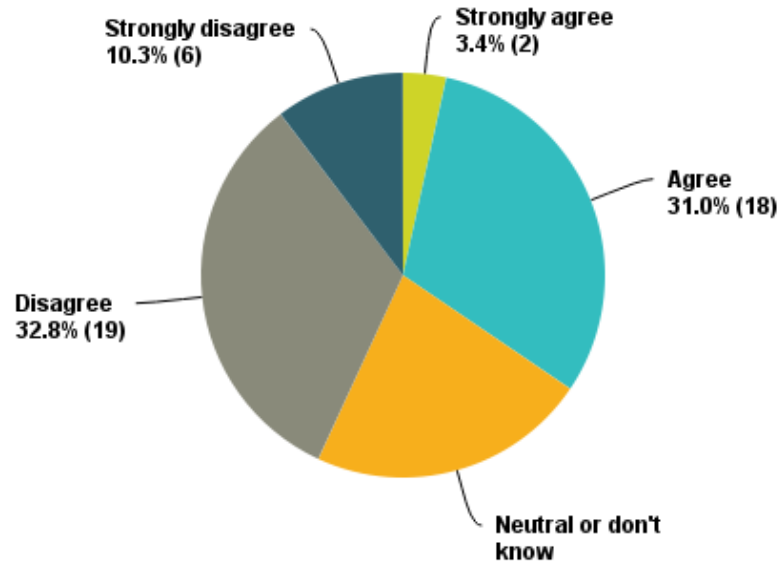

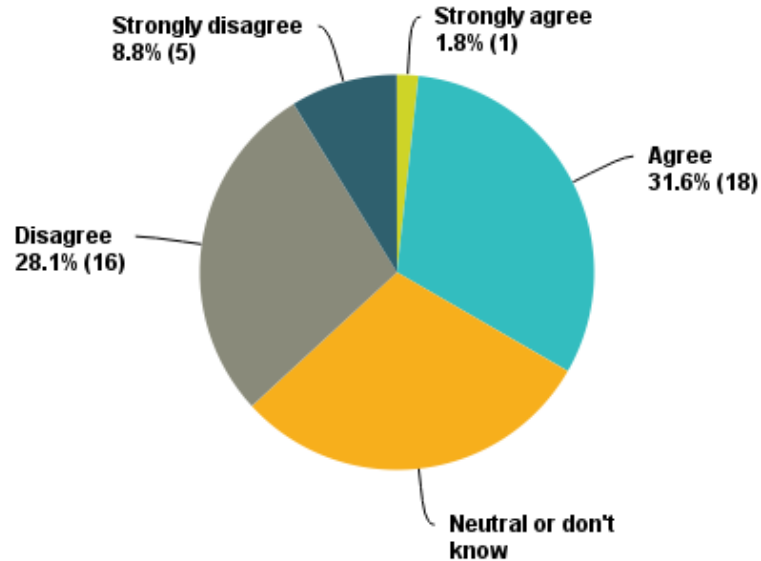

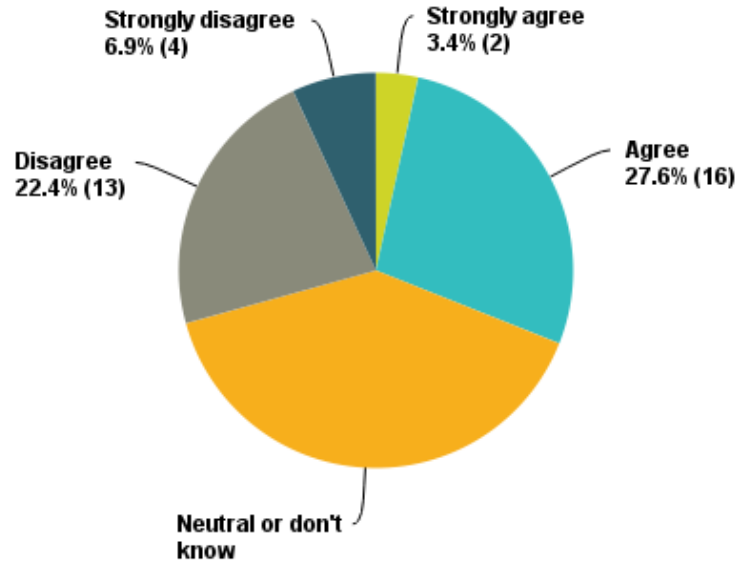

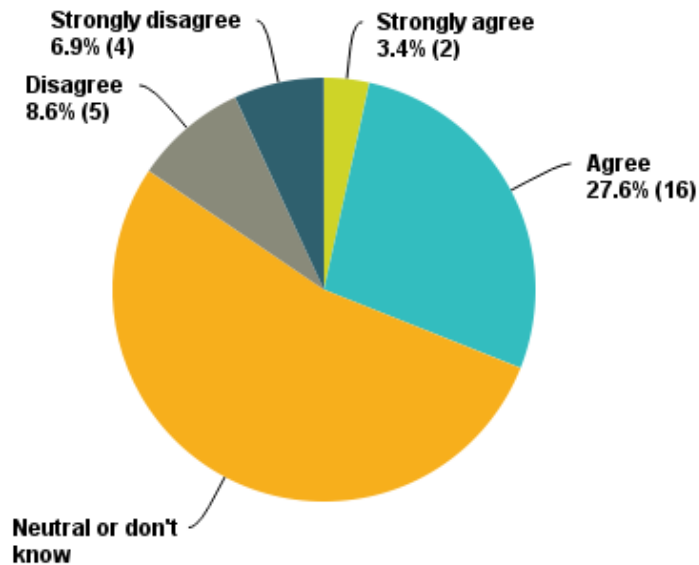

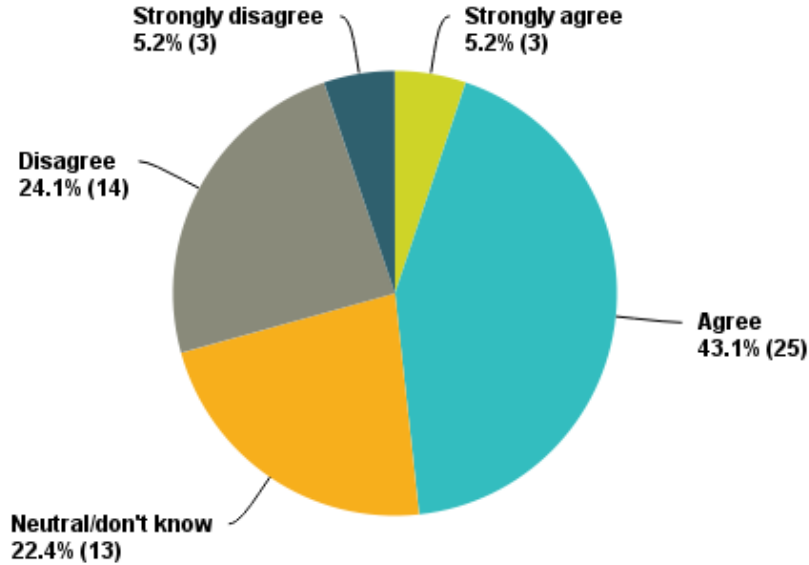

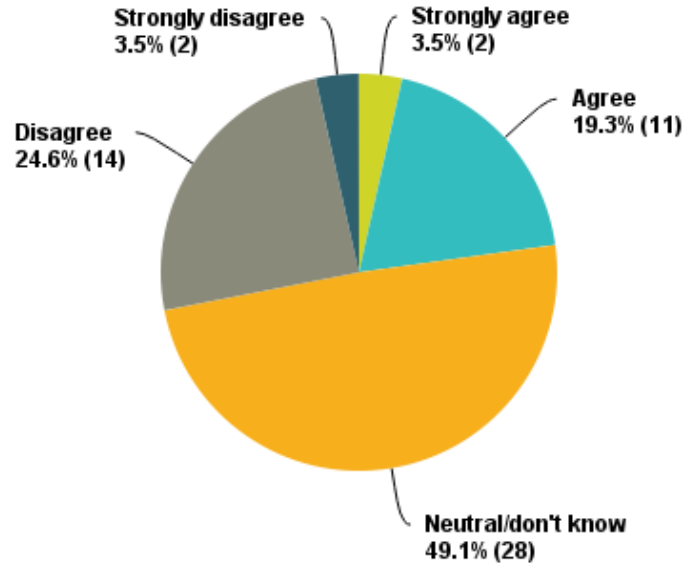

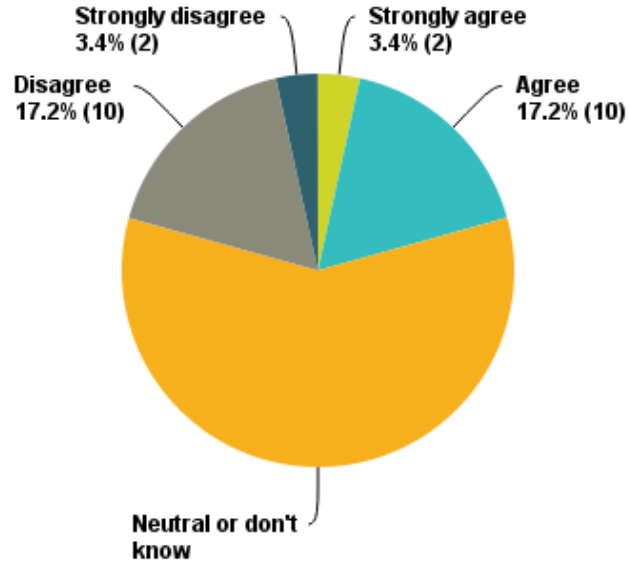

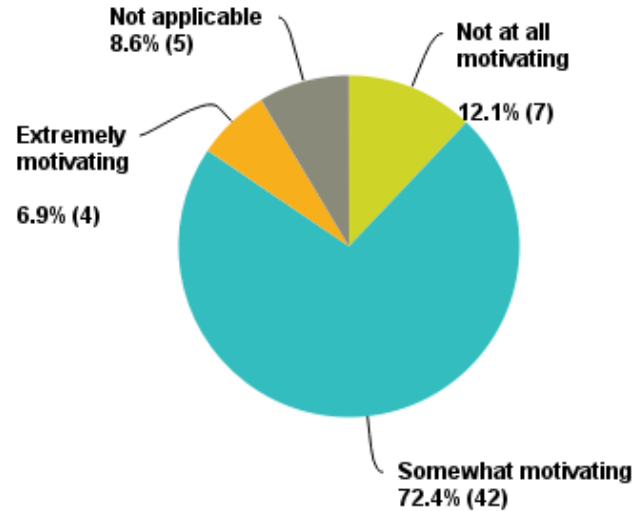

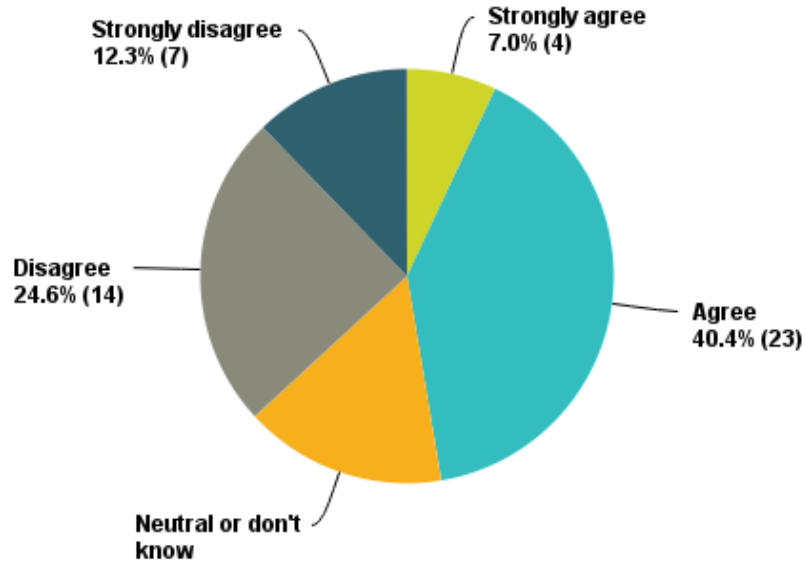

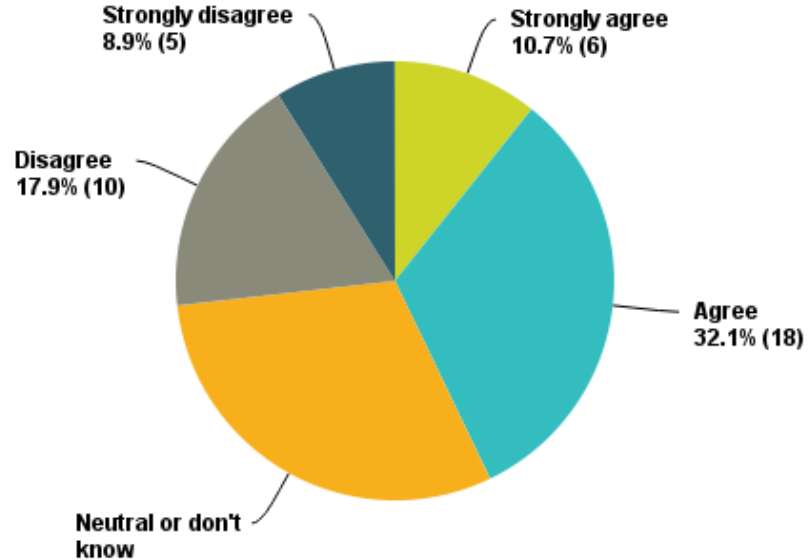

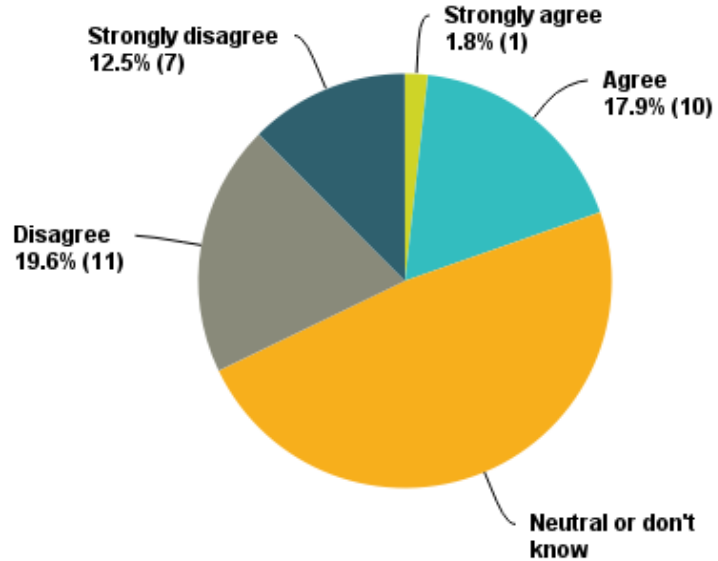

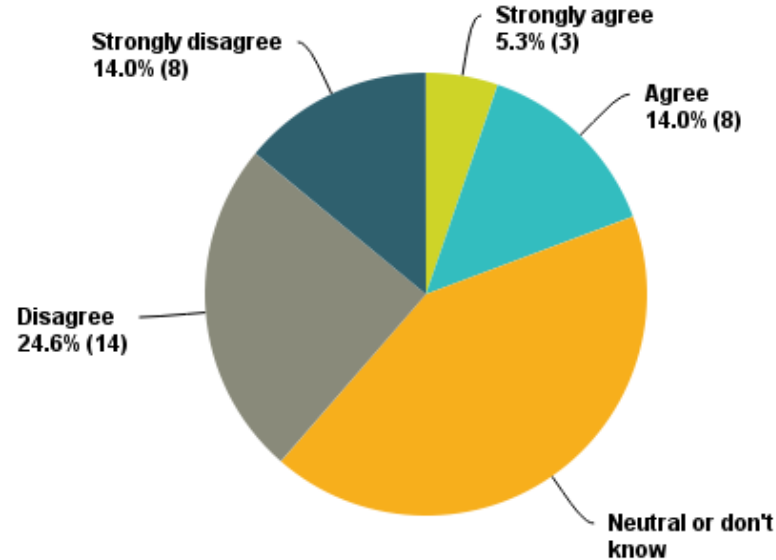

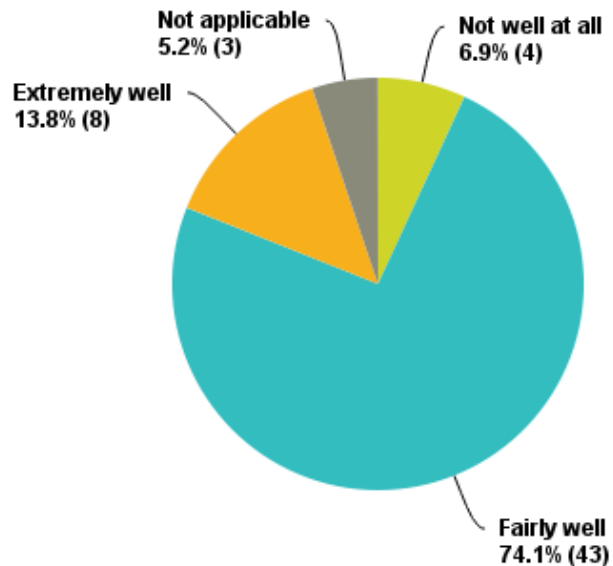

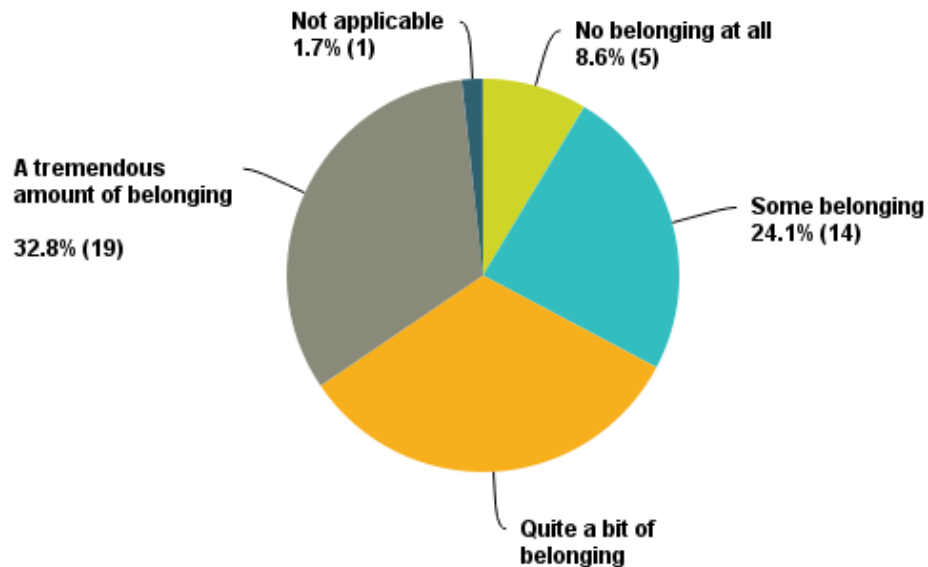
Q27: How well do you feel your child's school is preparing him or her for his or her next academic year?

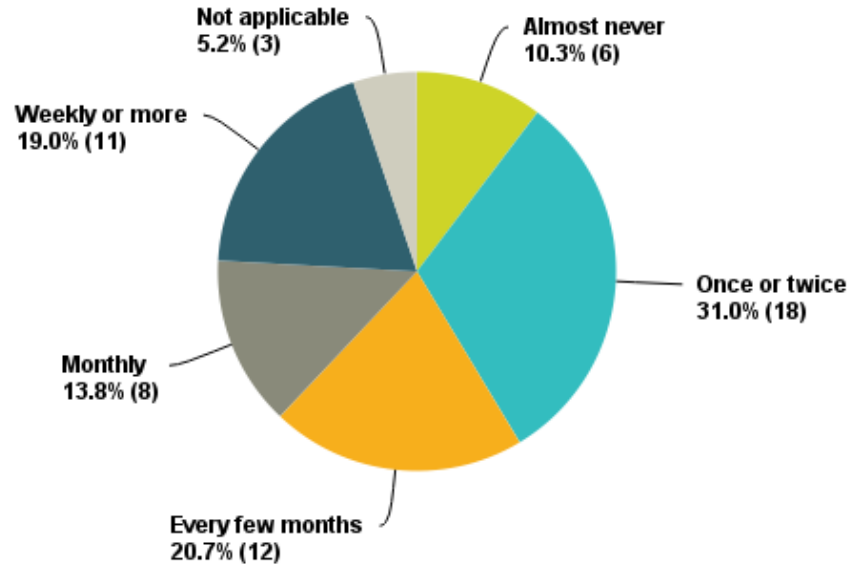
Q28: How much of a sense of belonging does your child feel at his or her school?

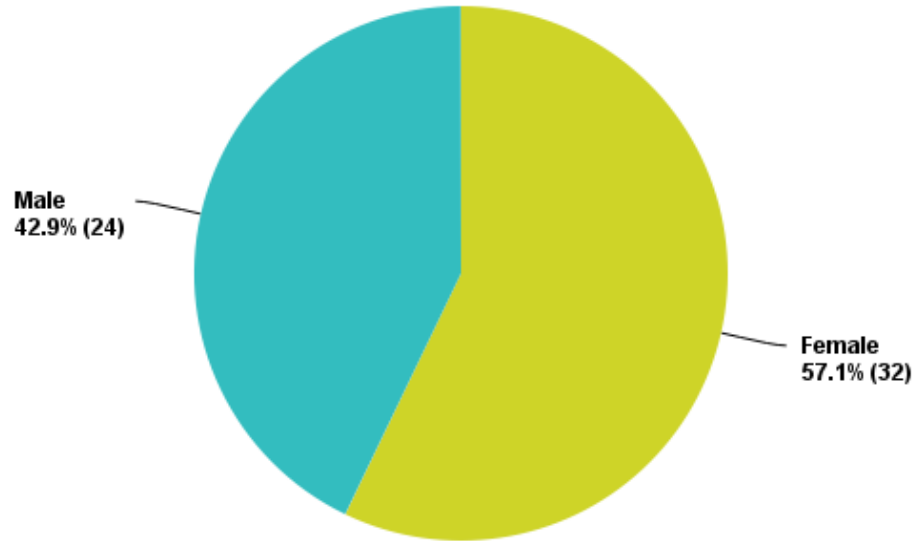
Q29: In the past year, how often have you helped out at your child's school?

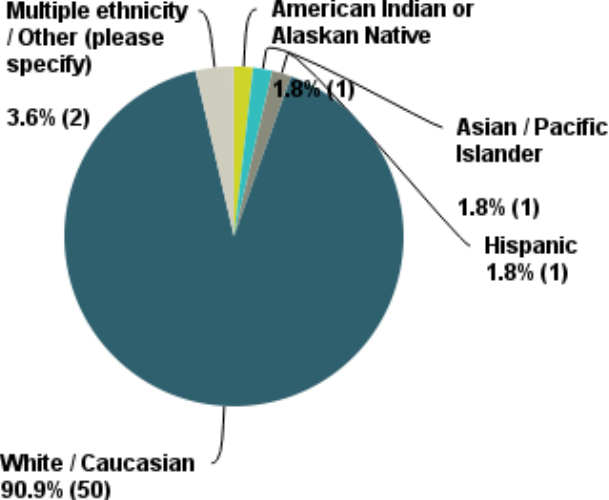

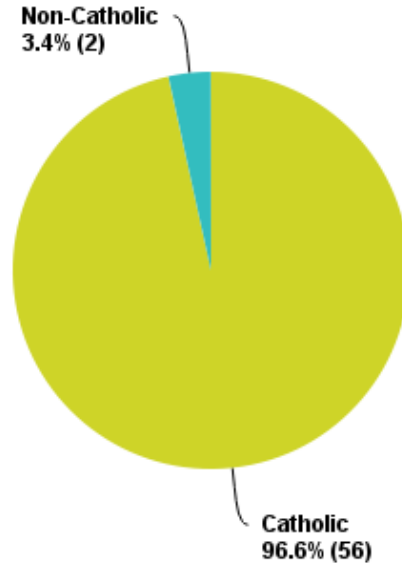
